Scotland at your feet

Launch of Mapland Scotland

The largest map of Scotland *ever produced!*



Created using over 600 map tiles from the Ordnance Survey Landranger 1:50,000 scale. The digital map data was electronically stitched together creating enormous, almost unmanageable computer files. These files were then digitally printed directly onto 37 No. 1.5m x 3m plastic boards, using solvent free UV inks (which not only reduces the environmental impact, but also adds extra durability when compared to conventional self adhesive floor vinyls).

A flat bed digital cutter using optical recognition software was then used to produce the 180 jigsaw pieces from the 37 boards.

Each jigsaw piece is approx. 1m x 0.7m making up a total area of 120 square metres showing Scotland to scale at 2cm to 1km.

The giant walkover jigsaw map measures 15m x 8m and displays the whole of Scotland including all of the islands.
